The JPK Project is a vibrant local charity managed by Chair and co-founder Jill Parker, MBE, and four Trustees. We are currently seeking a further Trustee to join the Board.

We have made great progress in our aims to create a Supported Living Centre for individuals with learning difficulties since we founded in 2001. Having bought our site in Old Town and secured consent for our plans, 2017 saw the completion of the initial development phase; a new Community Centre, featuring a Tea Room, Bakery and Training Facility. We are now focused on opening this during 2018 and working towards further development of the site to create residential accommodation.

Our charity enjoys enormous support locally but relies upon a dedicated team of people to manage it who are passionate about improving the lives of others and the realisation of this much-needed new service.

From experience we know that Trustees flourish and enjoy their work if they have a specific focus. Therefore each JPK Project Trustee has a Lead Role within the Board, typically reflecting their knowledge, skills and interest. We also know that experience of people with a learning disability is really important.

You may be friends with or related to someone with a learning disability and interested in sharing your professional skills and/or knowledge in one or more of the following areas:

- Finance
- Management
- Human Resources

Meetings are not onerous and usually last approximately two hours. They generally take place bi-monthly. In addition to our Trustees, the Board has a range of advisers the Trustees can approach for additional advice, including a solicitor and accountant.
